

Westwood Hills A.H. - Feline Lifetime Wellness Schedule

Please remember that this is a wellness schedule. If your pet becomes ill, additional diagnostics will be necessary.

Up to 85% of pets older than 3 years have dental disease! Dogs and cats aren't supposed to have bad breath. They have bad breath because they don't brush their teeth. Advanced dental disease can be painful, not to mention costly. If you are unable to brush your pet's teeth daily consider having a dental cleaning performed once a year.

Senior at Eight

Pets don't age the way people do- they age much faster. Most pets are considered seniors at 8 years of age. These pets should visit the vet more frequently.

- ❖ Year round, monthly flea/tick preventions are always recommended.

8 weeks

- Physical exam
- Weight
- Distemper vaccine (1/3)
- Intestinal Parasite screening
- Dewormer

12 weeks

- Physical exam
- Weight
- FIV/FELV testing
- Distemper (2/3) vaccine
- Leukemia vaccine (1/2)
- Intestinal Parasite screening
- Dewormer (if needed)
- Dental exam

16 weeks

- Physical exam
- Weight
- Rabies vaccine
- Distemper vaccine (3/3)
- Leukemia vaccine (2/2)
- Intestinal Parasite screening
- Dewormer (if needed)

4-6 Months

- Pre-surgical blood work (recommended)
- Spay/ Neuter surgery
- Microchip (recommended)

1-7 Years

- Physical exam
- Weight
- Intestinal Parasite screening
- Dewormer (if needed)
- Rabies vaccine (every three years)
- Annual distemper vaccine
- Leukemia vaccine (every 2 years)
- Junior wellness blood work
- Dental cleaning

8 years +

- Physical Exam
- Weight
- Parasite testing/dewormer
- Rabies vaccine (every three years)
- Annual distemper vaccine
- Leukemia vaccine (every 2 years)
- Dental cleaning
- Senior Wellness blood work + Urinalysis and Thyroid testing
